Four MAFFS C-130 airtankers and support personnel have been deployed to Port Hueneme, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally. Their respective units are as follows: 153rd Airlift Wing (WY Air National Guard), 302nd Airlift Wing (CO Air Force Reserve), 146th Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard), and 152nd Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard).

Sixty fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two hundred forty-five soldiers from the 14th Brigade Engineer Battalion and the 1st Battalion, 17th Infantry Regiment based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Boise National Forest. NIMO (Team 2) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Middle Fork Complex (2 fires), Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 5). IMT is also managing the Wapiti fire. Nine miles east of Garden Valley, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wapiti, Boise NF, USFS. Fourteen miles west of Stanley, ID. Timber, grass and brush. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and short-range spotting. Structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Flat, Southwest Area, Idaho Department of Lands. CIMT (GB Team 6) mobilizing. Eleven miles north of Idaho City, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with group torching, running and smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Boulder, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 2). IMT is also managing the Wolf Creek, Snag, Dollar and Goat fires. Nine miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, isolated torching and spotting. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Wolf Creek, Payette NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and isolated torching. Road and trail closures in effect.

Snag, Boise NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Cascade, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, running and spotting. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dollar, Boise NF, USFS. Eighteen miles northeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with torching, spotting and running. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Boise NF, USFS. Eleven miles southeast of Cascade, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with short crown runs and spotting. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Limepoint, Payette NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 4). Three miles southwest of Cuprum, ID. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with torching, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Merna Butte, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Eight miles west of Daniel, WY. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

Leeds Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. Eighteen miles southwest of Dubois, WY. Heavy slash and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closure in effect.

Diamond Complex (5 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 4). IMT is also managing the Middle Fork fire. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Middle Fork, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Timber and slash. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Willamette Complex (4 fires), Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (AK Team 3). CIMT (EA Team 1) mobilizing. Transfer of command from CIMT (CA Team 13) to CIMT (NW Team 7) will occur 8/21. IMTs are also managing the Ore fire. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ore, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Pioneer, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. CIMT (NW Team 3). IMT is also managing the Easy fire. Started on private land 10 miles southeast of Stehekin, WA. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Easy, Okanogan-Wenatchee NF, USFS. Seventeen miles west of Mazama, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Whisky Creek, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 10). IMT is also managing the Sandstone fire. Six miles southeast of Cascade Locks, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, creeping and backing. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Sandstone, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Nine miles southwest of Ripplebrook, OR. Brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with flanking, backing and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Lane 1, East Lane Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 1). Fifteen miles southeast of Springfield, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and light slash. Active fire behavior with backing and smoldering. Structures, energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Williams Mine, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). Four miles northwest of Trout Lake, WA. Brush, timber and heavy slash. Active fire behavior with backing, flanking and creeping. Communities and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Warner Peak, Sheldon-Hart Mountain NWR, FWS. CIMT (SW Team 1). Thirty-two miles northeast of Lakeview, OR. Brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with torching and smoldering. Structures and threatened. Area and road closures in effect. Sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Homestead Complex (6 Fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 8) to CIMT (NR Team 6) will occur today. Thirty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, backing and short-range spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dixon, Umpqua NF, USFS. IMT 1 (ODF Team 2). Eighteen miles east of Canyonville, OR. Timber and slash. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures, communities and communication infrastructure threatened. Area road and trail closures in effect.

Crazy Creek, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). Sixteen miles northeast of Paulina, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Battle Mountain Complex (2 fires), Pendleton Unit, Oregon DOF. CIMT (SW Team 3). Eight miles north of Ukiah, OR. Grass, hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Retreat, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. Transfer of command from CIMT (CA Team 14) to the local unit will occur today. Started on private land 14 miles southeast of Naches, WA. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Falls, Malheur NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 2) back to the local unit will occur tomorrow. IMT is also managing the Telephone fire. Twenty-six miles northwest of Burns, OR. Timber and grass. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and isolated torching. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect..

Telephone, Malheur NF, USFS. Sixteen miles northeast of Burns, OR. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Red, Deschutes NF, USFS. Eighteen miles west of Crescent, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ruby, North Cascades NP, NPS. Thirty-two miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, smoldering and single tree torching. Structures threatened. Area and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

2620 Road, Olympic Region-Department of Natural Resources, DNR. Twenty miles northwest of Bremerton, WA. Timber and slash. Active fire behavior and single tree torching, backing and spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Cougar Creek, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. Twenty-three miles southwest of Asotin, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Breezy and dry south to southwesterly winds will from the Columbia Basin south and eastward into the Sierra Front, much of Nevada, and southwest Idaho. Relative humidity will remain low, 5-15% for the Great Basin and southeast Oregon to 15-25% for the Columbia Basin. Elevated to critical conditions are most likely in Nevada, but pyrocumulonimbus development is possible on any very active fires in central Idaho. Hot and dry conditions will continue for New Mexico east of the Divide into the southern Plains as well, but cooler temperatures, albeit with relative humidity possible as low as 25%, will spread into the Lower Mississippi Valley behind a cold front that moved through last night.

Monsoon moisture will wane somewhat today, but isolated to scattered mainly wet thunderstorms will continue across Arizona, Utah, and Colorado. Isolated to scattered mixed wet and dry thunderstorms are possible on the north side of the monsoon moisture plume from east-central Idaho into much of Montana and Wyoming, with new ignitions possible. Cool and seasonable conditions with near or above 25% will continue near and west of the Cascades and west of the Sierra. Cooler temperatures are expected across the southeast Interior of Alaska today, but dry conditions will persist.
