One MAFFS C-130 airtanker and support personnel from the 152<sup>nd</sup> Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard) and one MAFFS C-130 airtanker and support personnel from the 146<sup>th</sup> Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Port Hueneme, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Sixty Fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two hundred forty-five soldiers from the 14th Brigade Engineer Battalion and the 1st Battalion, 17th Infantry Regiment based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Boise National Forest. NIMO (Team 2) is assigned to support the military contingent.

**Middle Fork Complex (2 fires)**, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 3). Nine miles east of Garden Valley, ID. Timber and brush. Extreme fire behavior with wind-driven runs, spotting and group torching. Numerous structures, communication and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Fish Creek**, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 1). Twenty-two miles southeast of Moran, WY. Heavy slash and timber. Extreme fire behavior with short crown runs and uphill runs. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Boulder**, Boise NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (GB Team 2) to CIMT (RM Team 2) will occur today. IMT is also managing the Wolf Creek, Snag, Dollar and Goat fires. Nine miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and torching. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

South to southwest winds of 15-30 mph with gusts of 30 to 40 mph amid relative humidity of 10-20 percent are expected across the eastern Great Basin up into Wyoming and central and eastern Montana today. Above normal temperatures and minimum relative humidity below 25 percent are likely to continue east of the Divide in the Southwest into the Southern Plains. Mixed wet/dry storms are forecast over the northern Great Basin into parts of the Northern Rockies. Showers will persist from the Cascades westward. Cooler temperatures and higher humidity levels will spread further south and east from the Pacific Northwest and northern California into the northern Great Basin and the western tier of the Northern Rockies curtailing significant fire potential. Monsoon moisture will continue to shift slowly eastward on Saturday creating areas of showers and mainly wet storms across eastern Arizona, eastern Utah, New Mexico west of the Divide, and western Colorado.

Temperatures in the southern Plains will remain above normal with afternoon relative humidity as low as 15% and southwesterly winds of 12-20 mph and gusts 20-25. In the Deep South, very warm and dry conditions with relative humidity as low as 35% will persist. Dry air will remain in place across the Appalachians and Ohio Valley with temperatures warming to above normal levels.
