One MAFFS C-130 airtanker and support personnel from the 152<sup>nd</sup> Airlift Wing (NV Air National Guard) and one MAFFS C-130 airtanker and support personnel from the 146<sup>th</sup> Airlift Wing (CA Air National Guard) have been deployed to Port Hueneme, CA to support wildland fire operations nationally.

Sixty Fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two hundred forty-five soldiers from the 14th Brigade Engineer Battalion and the 1st Battalion, 17th Infantry Regiment based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Boise National Forest. NIMO (Team 2) is assigned to support the military contingent.

**Wapiti**, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (RM Team 1). Fourteen miles west of Stanley, ID. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, group torching and spotting. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Middle Fork Complex (2 fires)**, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (GB Team 3). Nine miles east of Garden Valley, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, backing and smoldering. Residences threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Fish Creek**, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 1). Twenty-two miles southeast of Moran, WY. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with wind-driven runs, group torching and spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Boulder**, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (RM Team 2). IMT is also managing the Wolf Creek, Snag, Dollar and Goat fires. Nine miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Wolf Creek**, Payette NF, USFS. Eleven miles northwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Communication infrastructure threatened. Road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Snag**, Boise NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Cascade, ID. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Dollar**, Boise NF, USFS. Eighteen miles northeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Goat**, Boise NF, USFS. Eleven miles southeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

The mid-level trough of low pressure which advanced through the Pacific Northwest and Northern Californian Friday into Saturday is expected to weaken and lift out of the northern Great Basin into the Northern Rockies Sunday into Sunday night. Gusty southwest winds at 15-25 mph with gusts up to 30 mph are forecast to persist over the eastern Great Basin, Colorado, Wyoming, and the western and northern Plains on Sunday. Relative humidity levels of 10-25 percent are forecast over eastern Montana, central and eastern Wyoming, southern Great Basin, the deserts of southern California, portions of the Southwest, and the western Plains.

Cool conditions and minimum humidity levels above 25 percent are expected across the Pacific Northwest, northern California, and the northern Great Basin. Monsoonal moisture is forecast to shift further eastward over along and east of the divide creating areas of showers and storms. Scattered mixed wet/dry storms are forecast over the northern Great Basin.

Temperatures will drop slightly across the Southern Plains but remain above normal. Minimum relative humidities will improve slightly over the High Plains but are still expected to drop into the teens. Above normal temperatures will spread north and east into the rest of the Plains and Mississippi Valley as an upper ridge of high pressure intensifies over the central US. Gusty south to southwest winds are forecast over the High Plains up into the Central Plains Sunday afternoon.
