**Riley**, Tanana Zone, BLM. CIMT (AK Team 2). Started on NPS land nine miles southeast of Healy, AK. Timber and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

#### **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Temperatures will continue to increase in California with temperatures near or exceeding 110 degrees in the Central Valley. Locally breezy northwest winds are also possible in the Coast Ranges, especially near the central coast. Hot temperatures above 100 degrees will also spread into the western Great Basin, southwest Oregon, southern Great Basin, and much of the Sonoran and Mojave Deserts. Minimum relative humidity will be very low, 3-15%, with poor overnight recovery of 10-30%, especially for the mid-slopes and ridges of the Sierra foothills and portions of the Coast Ranges.

Dry air will spread across much of the West, with isolated thunderstorms confined to eastern Montana and portions of southern and eastern New Mexico. Scattered to widespread showers and thunderstorms will develop across the Plains, Midwest, and Ohio Valley, with heavy rain and flooding most likely in portions of Minnesota, northern Iowa, and western Wisconsin. Scattered thunderstorms are likely to develop along the Gulf Coast into Florida, but much of central and south Texas will remain dry with hot temperatures. A wetter pattern will continue for Alaska with wetting rain likely for much of the Interior, while south-central Alaska will be drier with cooler temperatures. Breezy trade winds with a few light windward showers are expected in Hawai'i.
