Sixty fireline management personnel from Australia and New Zealand are assigned to support large fires in the Northwest Area.

Two hundred forty-five soldiers from the 14th Brigade Engineer Battalion and the 1st Battalion, 17th Infantry Regiment based out of Joint Base Lewis McChord (JBLM) are deployed in support of wildland fire operations on the Boise National Forest. NIMO (Team 2) is assigned to support the military contingent.

Wapiti, Boise NF, USFS. CIMT (RM Team 1). CIMT (GB Team 7) is mobilizing. Fourteen miles west of Stanley, ID. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, torching and spotting. Numerous structures and several communities threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Glendale, Twin Falls District, BLM. Five miles southwest of Bellevue, ID. Brush and grass. Active fire behavior with running and flanking. Structures threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Middle Fork Complex (2 fires), Boise NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (GB Team 3) to CIMT (GB Team 5) will occur tomorrow. Nine miles east of Garden Valley, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Several communities threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Boulder, Boise NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (RM Team 2) to CIMT (RM Team 3) will occur on 9/6. IMTs are also managing the Snag, Goat and Dollar fires. Nine miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, group torching and single tree torching. Numerous structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Snag, Boise NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, group torching and single tree torching. Residences and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Goat, Boise NF, USFS. Eleven miles southeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, group torching and single tree torching. Communication and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Dollar, Boise NF, USFS. Eighteen miles northeast of Cascade, ID. Timber and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, group torching and single tree torching. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Fish Creek, Bridger-Teton NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 1). CIMT (NR Team 2) mobilizing. Twenty-two miles southeast of Moran, WY. Timber and brush. Active fire behavior with short crown runs, group torching and long-range spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Chimney, Eastern Supervisory Area Office, Idaho Department of Lands. Nine miles northwest of Fairfield, ID. Brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running, backing and creeping. Structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Mineral, Boise District, BLM. Started on private land 21 miles northwest of Weiser, ID. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with flanking and uphill runs. Structures threatened.

* **Berry**, Boise District, BLM. Eight miles northeast of Glens Ferry, ID. Grass and brush. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and backing. Residences and sage-grouse habitat threatened.

Big Flat, Boise District, BLM. Twenty-six miles east of Weiser, ID. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Structures and sage-grouse habitat threatened.

* **Lava**, Boise NF, USFS. Twelve miles southwest of Cascade, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with running, group torching and short-range spotting. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened.

* **Sheep**, Boise NF, USFS. Ten miles east of Idaho City, ID. Timber. Active fire behavior with uphill runs, flanking and backing. Communication infrastructure threatened.

Limepoint, Payette NF, USFS. Previously reported incident. Three miles southwest of Cuprum, ID. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

* **Shoe Fly**, Prineville Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 1). Forty-five miles northeast of Prineville, OR. Brush, grass and timber. Extreme fire behavior with running, spotting and wind-driven runs. Numerous structures threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

* **Rail Ridge**, Prineville, District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 10) mobilizing. Fifty-one miles northwest of Burns, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Active fire behavior with running and torching. Evacuations in effect.

Copperfield, Klamath Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 3). Five miles southeast of Chiloquin, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Moderate fire behavior with flanking, single tree torching and backing. Numerous structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect.

Diamond Complex (2 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (SA Team 3). IMT is also managing the Middle Fork fire. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Communication and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Middle Fork, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Willamette Complex (4 fires), Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 13). Transfer of command from CIMT (EA Team 1) to CIMT (NW Team 2) will occur tomorrow. IMTs are also managing the Ore fire. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Transportation and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ore, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing and flanking. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

Strong upper-level high pressure is forecast to build from the Desert Southwest northwestward to along the Northwest coast. Well above normal, including daily-record setting temperatures, are likely in the Desert Southwest as temperatures rise to up to 115°F. Well above normal temperatures will also spread into northern California and the Cascades westward to the coast with temperatures up to 100°F. Very low relative humidity of 5-20% is likely for much of California, Inland Northwest, Great Basin, and Southwest, west of the Divide, with poor overnight recovery of 15-30% for mid-slopes and ridges. Thermal troughing will also develop west of the Cascades in the Northwest increasing low-level instability. Temperatures will be closer to normal in the northern and central Rockies, although isolated mixed wet and dry thunderstorms are likely to continue in Colorado and Wyoming. Overall, winds are expected to be light across the West except for locally breezy westerly winds on the east slopes of the Wasatch in Utah.

The moisture from Texas is expected to move into the Lower Mississippi Valley Wednesday with widespread showers and thunderstorms and locally heavy rain, especially closer to the Gulf Coast. A weak cold front will move into the northern Plains and Upper Mississippi Valley with isolated showers and thunderstorms, but the Upper Ohio Valley is likely to remain very dry with relative humidity as low as 20% and light winds.
