**Line**, San Bernardino NF, USFS. IMT 1 (Cal Fire Team 3). Started on private land 10 miles east of San Bernardino, CA. Grass and chaparral. Active fire behavior with flanking and uphill runs. Numerous structures, energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Airport**, Orange County. CIMT (CA Team 2). Two miles northeast of Rancho Santa Margarita, CA. Grass, chaparral and brush. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. **Flat Top**, Deschutes NF, USFS. Ten miles north of Fort Rock, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous residences and energy infrastructure threatened.

**Firestone**, Deschutes NF, USFS. Twenty-one miles north of Fort Rock, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Residences, energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Rail Ridge**, Prineville, District, BLM. CIMT (CA Team 10). Fifty-one miles northwest of Burns, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures, communication

infrastructure and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Willamette Complex (4 fires)**, Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 2) and CIMT (NR Team 6). CIMT (EA Team 1) mobilizing. IMTs are also managing the Red and Ore fires. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, backing and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Red**, Deschutes NF, USFS. Eighteen miles west of Crescent, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Ore**, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Devils Knob**, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 13). Five miles southeast of Tiller, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Buck Creek**, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 10). Thirty miles southwest of Silver Lake, OR. Timber and medium slash. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Area closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

**Fossil Complex (3 fires)**, Fossil Unit, ODF. IMT 1 (ODF Team 2). Two miles northwest of Spray, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Evacuations and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

**Wiley Flat**, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). Thirty-one miles southeast of Prineville, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Homestead Complex (4 fires)**, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Thirty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Middle Fork**, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Trail closures in effect.

**Diamond Complex (2 fires)**, Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 14). IMT is also managing the Middle Fork fire. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Whisky Creek**, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Six miles southeast of Cascade Locks, OR. Timber, brush and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

**Sandstone**, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Nine miles southwest of Ripplebrook, OR. Brush, closed timber litter and timber. No new information. Last report unless new information is received.

## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

Strong south to southwesterly winds of 20-35 mph with gusts 35-50 mph will develop across much of the greater Four Corners into the Plains today. However, moisture will be elevated compared to the wind event last week, with relative humidity likely to remain near or above 15%. Scattered to widespread showers and scattered thunderstorms are likely with the upper low across much of Montana, with scattered thunderstorms in the central Rockies into the High Plains, while showers gradually end in southern Idaho and northern Nevada. Given the dry fuels along the Front Range and High Plains, several new ignitions are likely tomorrow due to the lightning. Farther west, light rain will spread along the Northwest coast into the Cascades, while strong onshore flow continues in southern California. Temperatures across much of the West will be well below normal tomorrow except along the Front Range into the Plains.

In the East, a decaying low-pressure system will move along the east side of the Appalachians, with areas of wetting rain into the central Appalachians, focused on the eastern slopes. Wetting rain will be more widespread near the Mid-Atlantic coast. To the northwest, it will remain very warm and dry in the Great Lakes into the Lower Ohio Valley, with relative humidity as low as 20%. Isolated showers and thunderstorms will continue along the northern Gulf Coast into Florida.
