## **Predictive Services Discussion:**

A cold front moving south along the Plains will interact with the moisture from the upper low moving out of the Southwest into the southern Plains to produce widespread showers and scattered thunderstorms from the Colorado Rockies into the Mid-Mississippi Valley. Showers and thunderstorms are expected in the Texas and Oklahoma panhandles, as well. However, ahead of the front, breezy/dry southerly winds of 15-20 mph gusting to 30 mph amid RH as low as 20% will develop in north Texas into central Oklahoma creating locally elevated conditions. Breezy/dry southwesterly winds are likely across central/western New Mexico, but recent moisture will mitigate any concern. Near normal temperatures and dry conditions are expected across much of the West Saturday, but California will begin to warm to above normal as upper-level ridging builds in. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms are expected in the central Appalachians into the Mid-Atlantic ahead of a weak cold front. Behind the front, locally breezy northwest winds of 10-15 mph develop in the Upper Ohio Valley and Lower Great Lakes with minimum RH as low as 20%.
