Covington Drive, South Carolina Forestry Commission. CIMT (FL State Team 1) mobilizing. Two miles west of Myrtle Beach, SC. Southern rough. No new information.

* **NE 90th Way**, Florida Forest Service. Started on private land four miles northwest of Williford, FL. Southern rough and tall grass. Active fire behavior with short-range spotting and torching.

* **Devils Jumps**, Big South Fork National River & Recreation Area, NPS. Nine miles northwest of Winfield, TN. Hardwood litter and brush. Active fire behavior with running, flanking and torching.

Hicks Cemetery, National Forests in North Carolina, USFS. Fourteen miles northwest of Clyde, NC. Hardwood litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Residences and communication infrastructure threatened.

Twin Oryx, Texas A&M Forest Service. Started on private land 25 miles southeast of Cotulla, TX. Grass. Moderate fire behavior with creeping.

* **Welder Complex**, Texas A&M Forest Service. Started on private land two miles northeast of Sinton, TX. Chaparral and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering.

* **East Parkway**, Tennessee DOF. Two miles southeast of Laurel, TN. Timber. Minimal fire behavior. Structures threatened.

Falls Dam, National Forests in North Carolina, USFS. Two miles east of Badin, NC. Timber and hardwood litter. Minimal fire behavior. Residences threatened.

Red Rose, Texas A&M Forest Service. Started on private land two miles south of San Diego, TX. Grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Residences threatened.

Two Barrel, National Forests in Florida, USFS. Twelve miles northeast of Wewahitchk, FL. Southern rough, timber and grass. Moderate fire behavior with running, flanking and creeping.

Jemike, Francis Marion & Sumter NF, USFS. Four miles northwest of Walhalla, SC. Dormant brush and timber. No new information.

Chestnut Mtn, Chattahoochee-Oconee NF, USFS. Six miles northwest of Resaca, GA. Timber. No new information.

Predictive Services Discussion:

A strong storm will continue to move into the Great Basin and desert Southwest today bringing more snow above 5,000 to 6,000 feet in the Central and Southern Rockies, along with some much needed rain to the southwest. Some light rain and snow will extend across the Central Plains into the southern Great Lakes today. Winds across southern New Mexico into the Big Bend region of Texas will continue to gust 30 to 40 mph with gusts of 20 to 30 mph extending up as far north an east as Kansas and Missouri. RH across the Southern Plains will remain 5 to 30%, while the Southeast and Mid-Atlantic will continue minimum RH of 20 to 30 percent. Above normal temperatures will continue across the Alaska along with heavy precipitation in the southeast part of the state. Strong trade winds will continue blow across Hawai'i today along with a few windward showers.
