Subject: Rescind NMAC Correspondence M2024-14 *National Preparedness Level 4 NMAC Management of Crews and Complex Incident Management Teams* effective September 26 at 0730 MDT

National Preparedness Level 3 (PL3) will be in effect at 0730 MDT on Thursday September 26. As a result, the National Multi-Agency Coordinating Group (NMAC) Correspondence M2024-14 *National Preparedness Level 4 NMAC Management of Crews and Complex Incident Management Teams* is rescinded simultaneously (0730 MDT on September 26, 2024).

The NMAC will continue to assign coordination responsibility for Type 1 and Type 2IA crew, Complex Incident Management Team (CIMT), smokejumper support functions.

The National CIMT Rotation will resume October 1, 2024. Please monitor the national rotation website for daily CIMT availability at <https://www.nifc.gov/nicc/logistics/overhead>.

In accordance with the National Interagency Standards for Resource Mobilization (NISRM), NMAC will monitor CIMT assignments and may engage with Geographic Areas as necessary to achieve team experience objectives, ensure proficiency, manage fatigue, or for other reasons.

The IMSR will continue to be produced daily.
